

KVoice Computers

What's in the box?



Notice there's an extra external Wi-Fi adapter at the side of the computer: this is to increase the range and quality of the Wi-Fi signal to your wireless router. Do not remove this adapter even if you are using a wired connection to your router.



Also in the box.

A white 4-socket *surge protector* extension power cable; a black power cable to connect the computer to the surge protector; and a green Ethernet cable optionally to connect the computer directly to your router.

A wired keyboard and mouse.

Place the computer onto a stable surface with plenty of space around it so you can work comfortably. Avoid touching the screen (use the blunt end of a pencil if you need to point). Never bring liquid—any kind of food or drink—near the computer at any time. If you can, use the optional green Ethernet cable because a wired connection to your router provides a much stronger and more reliable signal than Wi-Fi. When you switch on, always allow the computer at least two minutes uninterrupted to fully settle all its start-up processes before you begin work; give it some time to get ready for you. The PC automatically will log you in as an administrator with the username *kvoice*.
